

STAGE FRIGHT

"Stage fright", also known as "performance anxiety", is the nervousness or fear experienced by individuals when speaking or performing in front of an audience

STAGE FRIGHT

Stage fright is a common phenomenon experienced by many individuals when faced with the prospect of speaking in public. This anxiety can manifest in physical, emotional, and cognitive symptoms, creating a challenging hurdle for effective communication





FORMER US PRESIDENT BARACK OBAMA TALKING TO A LARGE AUDIENCE IN LAS VEGAS


- □It is very essential to weigh the composition of your audience in terms of demographics such as gender, age, qualification, and experience




THE OCCASION AND LOCATION OF SPEECH DELIVERY

- □It is important to find out where the speech is taking place, as the audience is often influenced by the environment in which the speech is given



WRITING THE SPEECH


- □Writing the speech, have an outline of the speech in an organised manner




